Reflection

He was old, tired, and sweaty, pushing his homemade cart down the alley, stopping now and then to poke around in somebody's garbage. I wanted to tell him about EUCHARIST But the look in his eyes, the despair on his face, the hopelessness of somebody else's life in his cart, Told me to forget it. So I smiled, said "Hi - and gave him EUCHARIST.

A woman lived alone, her husband dead, her family gone, and she talked at you, not to you, words, endless words, spewed out. So I listened - and I gave her EUCHARIST.

I laughed at myself, and told myself, "You, with all your sin, and all your selfishness, I forgive you, I accept you, I love you." It's nice and so necessary to give yourself EUCHARIST.

My God, When will we learn - you cannot talk EUCHARIST You cannot philosophize about it - YOU DO IT. You don't dogmatize EUCHARIST. Sometimes you laugh it, sometimes you cry it, often you sing it.

You see EUCHARIST in another's eyes, give it in another's hand held tight, squeeze it in an embrace. You pause EUCHARIST in the middle of a busy day, speak EUCHARIST will a million things to do, and a person who wants to talk.
